Day 1: Mumbai - Madrid

Assemble at your nearest airport to board flight for Madrid. Madrid is the Capital and largest City of Spain, Madrid is best known for its great cultural and artistic Heritage, Arrive and check in Hotel. **Overnight at Madrid (D)**

Day 2: Madrid

After breakfast, proceed for a Orientation City Tour of Madrid. We shall proceed to visit **Prado Museum** Commissioned in 1785, the museum arguably contains the finest Spanish art collection in the world- Gran Via,- Plaza de Espana,- University- Moncloa- Habsburg and Bourbons quarter – Calle Mayor, Puerta del Sol,- Puerta de Alcala,- The Bullring,- Columbus square,- Paseo de la Castellana, Bernabeu Stadium,- Plaza Castilla,- Cibeles fountain,- Royal Palace. In the evening, time free for the shopping in Capital of Spain. **Overnight in Madrid (B, L, D)**

Day 3: Madrid – Seville (Approx 5 hrs 30 mins – 534 Kms)

After breakfast proceeds to Seville by Road, Seville was founded over 2,000 years ago by the Romans, who were displaced from the region early in the 8th century by the Moors. Arrive & check in at hotel. **Overnight at Seville (B, L, D)**

Day 4: Seville

After Breakfast we will proceed to Orientation city tour to visit to Maria Luisa Park with the squares of Spain and America, the Palace of Saint Telmo (Andalucia's President

House), the former Tobacco Factory, the Monument dedicated to the famous soldier El Cid, the Pavilions of the Expo-Fair in 1929, the Guadalquivir river, and the Tower of Gold - Torre del Oro, The Seville Cathedral which is the largest Gothic cathedral and the third-largest church in the world, It was registered in 1987 by Unesco as a World Heritage Site, The cathedral is also the burial site of Christopher Columbus. After this we can proceed to visit **Flamenco Show. Overnight at Seville (B, L, D)**

Day 5: Seville – Ronda (Optional) - Marbella (188 Kms – Approx. 3 hours)

After breakfast we will proceed to Ronda, Ronda is a mountaintop city in Spain's Malaga province that's set dramatically above a deep gorge. This gorge (El Tajo) separates the city's circa-15th-century new town from its old town, dating to Moorish rule. Puente Nuevo, a stone bridge spanning the gorge, has a lookout offering views. New town's Plaza de Toros, a legendary 18th-century bullring, is one of the city's most recognizable landmarks. Further proceed to Marbella, Marbella is a city and resort area on southern Spain's Costa del Sol, part of the Andalusia region. The Sierra Blanca Mountains are the backdrop to 27 km of sandy Mediterranean beaches, villas, hotels, and golf courses. West of Marbella town, the Golden Mile of prestigious nightclubs and coastal estates leads to Puerto Banús marina, filled with luxury yachts, and surrounded by upmarket boutiques and bars. For the rest of the period we can enjoy the beaches of Marbella. Also the day can be kept as free day to enjoy the coastal area of Marbella. **Overnight at Marbella (B, L, D)**

Day 6: Marbella – Alicante (526 Kms – approx. 5 hrs. 30 mins)

After breakfast we will proceed to Alicante. Alicante is a port city on Spain's southeastern Costa Blanca, and the capital of the Alicante province. Its old town, Barrio de la Santa Cruz, has narrow streets, colored houses and a nightlife scene. From here, an elevator or a steep climb leads to medieval Castillo de Santa Bárbara, set on a hilltop with sweeping views of the Mediterranean coast. We will visit **Castillo de Santa Bárbara**, at a height of 166 metres, stands one of Spain's largest mediaeval fortresses, providing great views of Alicante's perfect bay. It has three different enclosures from three distinct periods. **Overnight at Alicante (B,L,D)**

Day 7: Alicante – Valencia (165 Kms – 2 hours)

After breakfast we will proceed to Valencia. After check in we precede to Orientation city tour of Valencia. The City of Arts and Sciences is an entertainment-based cultural and architectural complex in the city of Valencia, Spain. It is the most important modern tourist destination in the city of Valencia and one of the 12 Treasures of Spain. L'Oceanogràfic is an oceanarium situated in the east of the city of Valencia, Spain, where different marine habitats are represented. It was designed by the architect Félix Candela and the structural engineers Alberto Domingo and Carlos Lázaro. The Llotja de la Seda is

a late Valencian Gothic-style civil building in Valencia, Spain. It is a principal tourist attraction in the city. **Overnight at Valencia (B, L, D)**

Day8: Valencia – Barcelona (351 Kms – Approx 4 hrs.)

After breakfast proceed to Barcelona. Arrive Barcelona - is the capital of the Spanish community of Catalonia, home of the world famous architect Gaudi, and is one of the most beautiful and vibrant cities in Spain. In the afternoon day free to explore the city on your own **Overnight at Barcelona (B, L, D)**

Day 9: Barcelona

After breakfast we proceed for a city tour, in the afternoon the tour will continue along the Paseo de Gracia to see Gaudi's famous apartment buildings including Casa Batllo then visit Gaudi's fabulous Guell Park declared an artistic monument and world heritage site by UNESCO. You will then go back to admire the **Sagrada Familia** (Holy Family) Church, Gaudi's Unfinished masterpiece You'll also visit Barcelona's Monumental Bull Ring and the Picasso Museum which exhibits works from the blue and pink periods of the world - famous painter. We also visit the Plaza de Catalunya, Via Layetana, the Cathedral and its cloister. You'll tour the Gothic Quarter with its evidence of the Roman and Medieval periods. Next you'll see the drive along the Paseo Colon past the Monument of Christopher Columbus and up to the top of Montjuich from where you'll enjoy a panoramic view of the city, the harbor, and the Olympic complex. Explore the Spanish Village which reproduces the most typical regional architectural styles in Spain. Further visit biggest stadium of Spain **Camp Naou**. Later free for continue exploring the complex. **Overnight at Barcelona (B, L, D)**

Day 10: Barcelona – Salou – Barcelona (Approx 1 Hour 30 mins – 111 Km)

After Breakfast we shall proceed to Salou , Enjoy Port Aventura World, PortAventura World is an entertainment resort in Salou, Tarragona, on the Costa Daurada in Spain. It was built around the PortAventura theme park, which attracts around 4 million visitors per year. Enjoy beautiful rides & Beaches at Salou. Later we will proceed to Barcelona for Dinner. **Overnight at Barcelona (B,L,D)**

Day 11: Barcelona - Home Bound Destination

After breakfast we depart for the airport to board flight for the home bound destination. The Tour will end with beautiful memories. (B)
