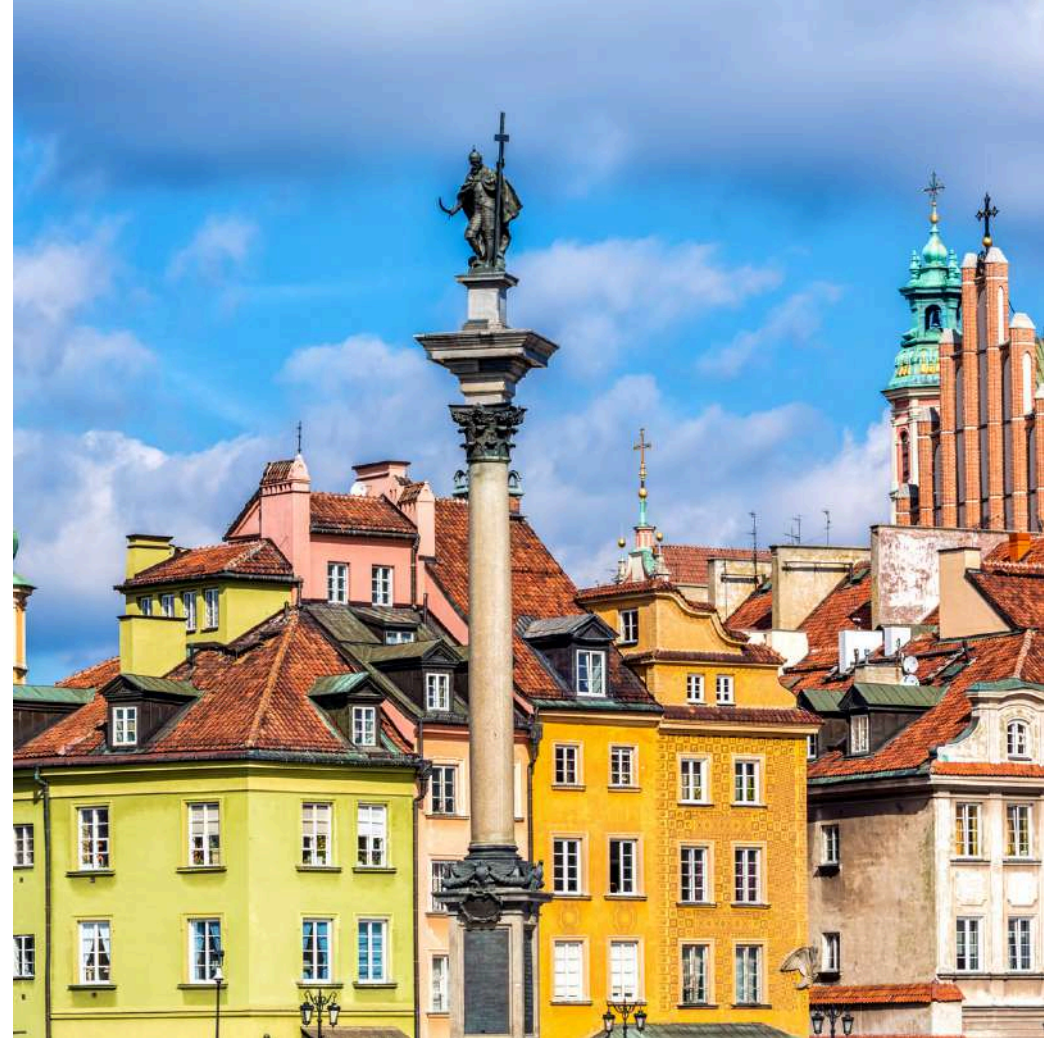

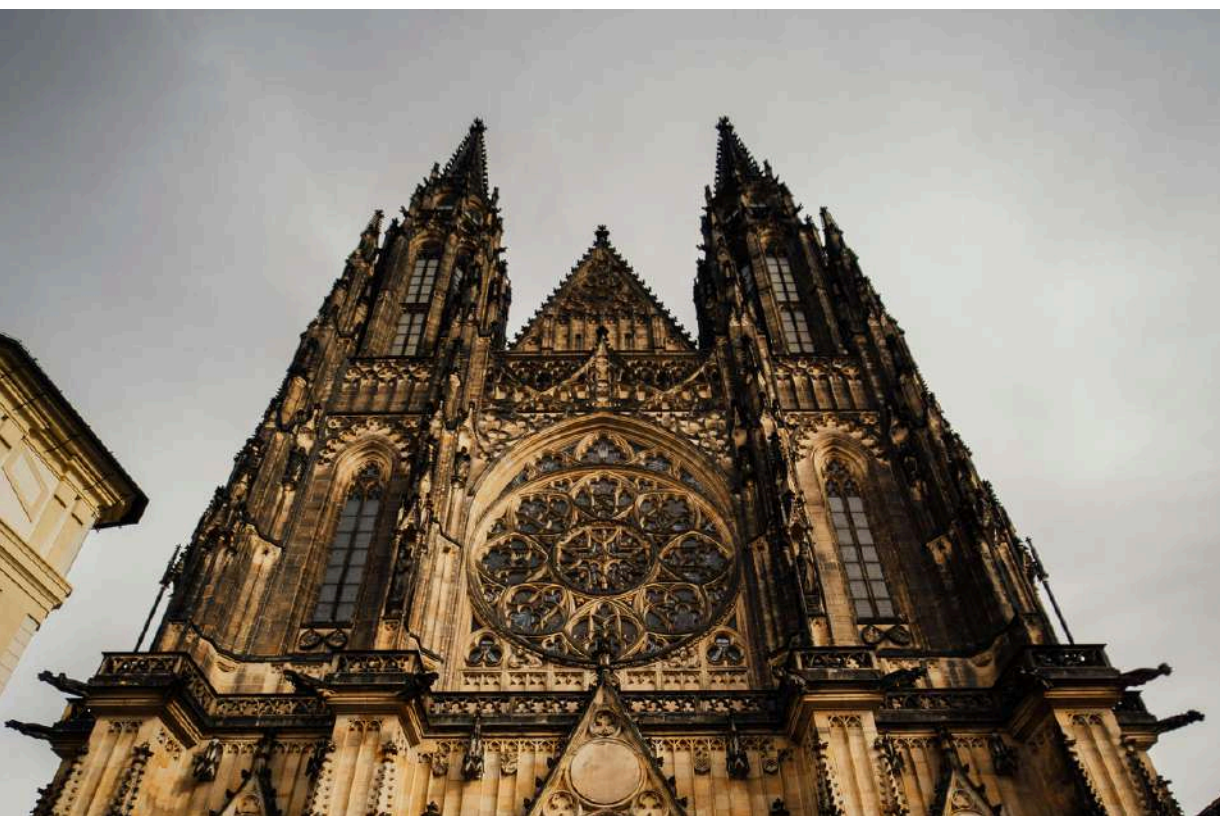
Day 5 – Krakow to Prague: Enter the Land of Bohemian Legends

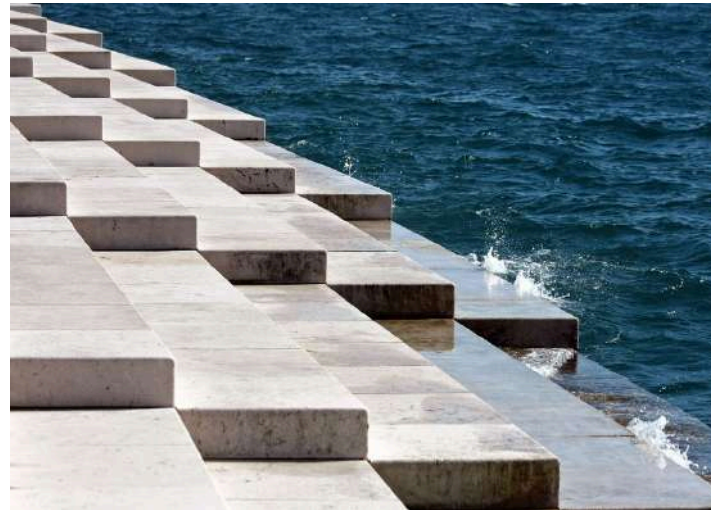
Day 11 – Ljubljana to Plitvice National Park + Guided Nature Experience

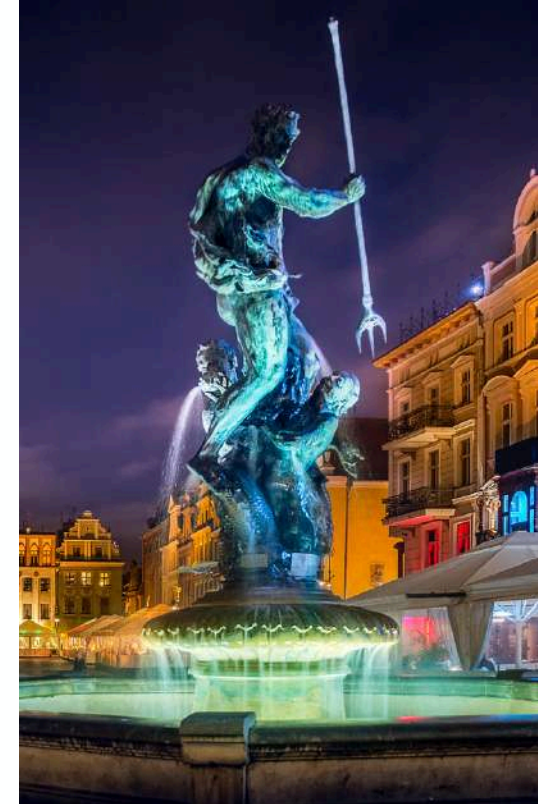
