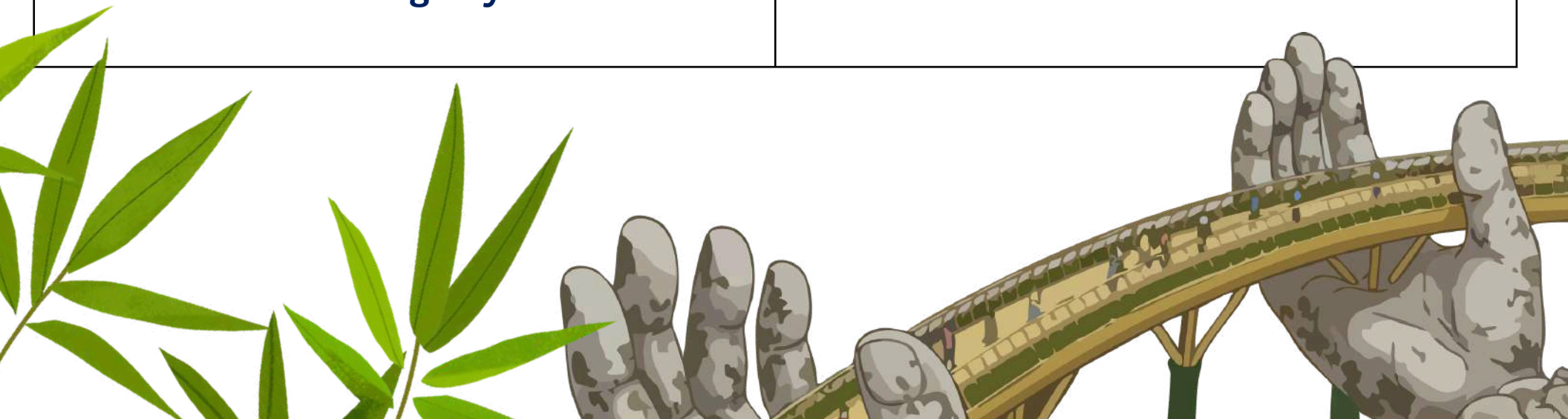

DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN PHU QUOC – THE PEARL ISLAND AWAITS

Morning flight to Phu Quoc Island.

Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel and check in **(check in time at 3:00 pm onward)**

Afternoon, you will be transferred to visit Grand World Phu Quoc, an entertainment and shopping complex belonging to Phu Quoc United Center. It is located right at Long Beach in Ganh Dau Commune a well-known place in Phu Quoc Island. Although it was just inaugurated at the end of 2020, it has quickly become one of the must-see destinations in the pearl island for any tourist. Enjoy your free time in the island. Overnight in Phu Quoc

DAY 2 : PHU QUOC – VINPEARL SAFARI & VINWONDER

After breakfast, proceed to Vinpearl Safari, Phu Quoc's open zoo built on a 500-hectare semi-wild model. Home to around 3,000 animals from 150 species, the park focuses on the care and conservation of rare wildlife in a natural environment. In the afternoon, transfer to VinWonders Phu Quoc, one of Vietnam's largest theme parks. Enjoy its six themed zones – European Street, Fantasy World, Viking Village, The Seashell, Adventure World and Typhoon World – featuring 12 civilization-inspired themes and over 100 modern rides and attractions. Overnight in Phu Quoc.

DAY 3: HON THOM ISLANDS BY CABLE CARS – SUNSET TOWN

Today, transfer to visit Hon Thom Island (Pineapple Island) by cable car. Moving by cable car, you will see the panoramic view of the green beauty of the large emerald-colored waters right below. Time for cable car travel is quite averaging 30 minutes, so take advantage of sightseeing and taking photo memories. Enjoy your leisure time at Water Park and Theme Park (ticket included). Other sports games at your own expense. Then take the car back to Phu Quoc main island. Then visit: Kiss Bridge. On the pearl island of Phu Quoc, in the romantic atmosphere of the Mediterranean town and the immense sea, Kiss Bridge appears as a spectacular symbol of love, intimacy and harmony. This unique bridge takes inspiration from the endless love, the sweet kisses, and the love story of Nguu Lang and Chuc Nu in Vietnamese fairy tales. Transfer back to hotel and overnight in Phu Quoc.

DAY 4: PHU QUOC – FLIGHT TO DA NANG

Morning flight to Da Nang. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel and check in at 2:00 PM. Later, visit the Marble Mountains, a cluster of five marble and limestone hills featuring caves, shrines, pagodas and Buddhist temples, along with stunning views of My Khe Beach and the surrounding landscape. Continue to the iconic Dragon Bridge, one of Da Nang's most famous landmarks. Next, visit Linh Ung Son Tra Pagoda, the largest pagoda in Da Nang, beautifully situated on the Son Tra Peninsula and known for its impressive architecture and scenic sea and mountain views.

Conclude the tour with a visit to a local market and enjoy free time for shopping before returning to the hotel. Overnight in Da Nang.

DAY 05: DA NANG – FULL DAY BA NA HILLS – GOLDEN BRIDGE – DA NANG

Morning transfer to Ba Na Hills via the scenic Nguyen Tat Thanh coastal road and Red Beach. Ride the world-famous cable car, holder of two Guinness World Records, and enjoy breathtaking views of lush forests and waterfalls. Visit the iconic Golden Bridge, French Villas, and Ling Ung Pagoda with its 27m-high Buddha statue. Continue by cable car to the summit of Chua Mountain (1,487m) for panoramic views of Da Nang. Explore Dreaming Stream, Rainbow Waterfall, Suspension Bridge, Golden Valley, and the ruined Opera House. Enjoy 105 exciting games at Fantasy Park, one of Vietnam's largest indoor entertainment zones, and interact with wild monkeys before returning to the cable car station. Back to the hotel for an overnight stay in Da Nang.

DAY 6: DA NANG – COCONUT JUNGLE – HOI AN ANCIENT TOWN – DA NANG

Afternoon visit to Cam Thanh Coconut Village, a charming destination surrounded by lush coconut groves and rich flora & fauna. Enjoy a peaceful boat ride, experience the local fishing lifestyle, and soak in the serene natural beauty. Continue to the UNESCO-listed Hoi An Ancient Town, a historic trading port renowned for its unique blend of Vietnamese, Chinese, and Japanese architecture. Explore the town on foot, visiting Hoi An Market, ancient houses, Chinese Assembly Halls, traditional handicraft workshops, and the iconic Japanese Covered Bridge. Enjoy the town's timeless charm and free time for shopping before returning to your hotel. Overnight in Da Nang.

DAY 07: DA NANG – FLIGHT TO HANOI – SAPA SCENIC JOURNEY

Morning transfer to the airport for your flight to Hanoi. Upon arrival, proceed on a scenic drive to Sapa (approximately 5.5–6 hours), passing through the picturesque countryside of Northern Vietnam. Along the way, admire breathtaking landscapes featuring terraced rice fields, rolling tea plantations, lush forests, winding mountain roads, and traditional ethnic villages. Arrive in Sapa and check in to your hotel at 2:00 PM. After some time to relax and refresh, enjoy the rest of the day at leisure to explore the charming mountain town, local markets, and surrounding scenery at your own pace. Overnight stay in Sapa

DAY 08 : FANSIPAN MOUNTAIN

Today you will have great experience to “Roof of Indochina” – Fansipan Mount Peak in Sapa. By cable car, you’ll have a seat tight in a cabin within only 15 minutes to reach the top of Fansipan, towering majestically at 3143 meters above the sea. The cable route has welcomed thousands of coming tourists to Sapa to make their dream of conquering the highest Indochina peak to be real. On the cable car you are above forest, waterfall, through and above clouds... Visit Pagoda in the mist, stand at the top surrounded by clouds and bathed in golden sunlight, check in photo at peak of mountain... All stunning view are there with you. Then, transfer to Glass Bridge to experience walking among cloud.

End of the tour, back to hotel & overnight

DAY 09 : SAPA-HANOI- CITY TOUR

Morning, we transfer back to Hanoi

Morning, transfer back to Hanoi. In the afternoon, enjoy a half-day Hanoi City Tour and discover the charm of Vietnam's vibrant capital, known for its rich history, ancient temples, bustling markets, and elegant French colonial architecture. Visit the iconic Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum and Ba Dinh Square (outside), with views of the Vietnam Parliament House and Presidential Palace. Continue to the historic Tran Quoc Pagoda, Hanoi's oldest pagoda, beautifully situated on an island in West Lake. Later, stop at the picturesque Hoan Kiem Lake before taking a leisurely walk through the lively Hanoi Old Quarter, famous for its narrow streets, traditional houses, and local atmosphere. Return to your hotel for an overnight stay in Hanoi.

DAY 10 : NINH BÌNH – TRANG AN CAVE & HOA LU – HANOI

Start your day with a visit to Ninh Binh Province, beginning at Hoa Lu, the ancient royal capital of Vietnam. Explore the historic temples dedicated to King Dinh Tien Hoang, King Le Dai Hanh, and King Ly Thai To, while learning about Vietnam's first three feudal dynasties.

In the afternoon, continue to the stunning Trang An Landscape Complex and enjoy a peaceful sampan boat ride through winding waterways, limestone mountains, lush valleys, and mysterious water caves. Discover sacred sites, admire the breathtaking scenery, and experience the unique beauty of this UNESCO-listed destination. After the tour, transfer back to Hanoi. Overnight stay in Hanoi.

DAY 11 : HANOI - HA LONG BAY WITH OVERNIGHT ON CRUISE

Today, depart from Hanoi for the spectacular Halong Bay, known as the "Dragon Descending to the Sea" and recognized twice by UNESCO as a World Natural Heritage Site. Upon arrival, board your overnight cruise and check into your ocean-view cabin. Enjoy a delicious lunch as the cruise sails past stunning limestone grottoes, floating villages, and pristine beaches. Take part in activities such as swimming and kayaking amidst the breathtaking scenery. In the evening, enjoy dinner on board and relax as you spend an unforgettable night cruising through the magnificent waters of Halong Bay.

DAY 12: HA LONG BAY – HANOI -DEPARTURE

Begin your day with a refreshing Tai Chi session on the sundeck or enjoy the stunning sunrise over the limestone mountains of Halong Bay. After a light breakfast, continue cruising through the bay, taking in more of its breathtaking scenery and unique rock formations.

Later, enjoy lunch on board as the cruise makes its way back to the harbor. Disembark at around 11:00 AM and transfer back to Hanoi. Upon arrival, proceed to Hanoi Airport for your onward departure flight with wonderful memories of your Vietnam journey.
