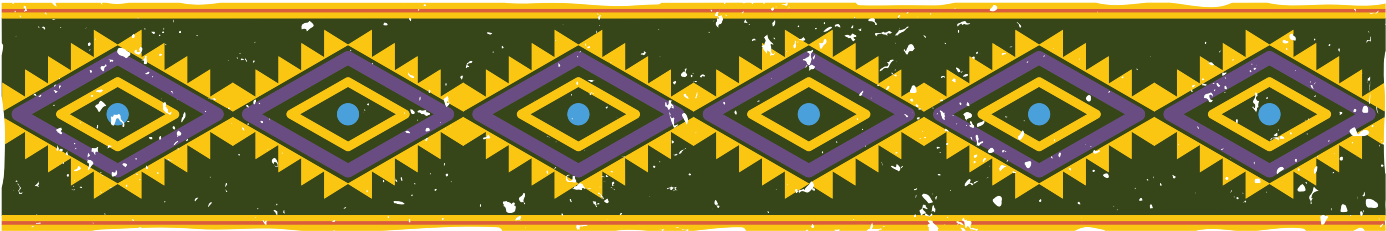

Day 1- Arrival in Rio de Janeiro

Day 2: Rio de Janeiro

DAY 3: RIO DE JANEIRO

Day 6: Iguazu Falls – Buenos Aires

Day 17: Iquitos (Amazon)

In the evening, experience a fascinating Medicine Man ceremony at the hotel, offering insight into the region's ancient healing traditions.

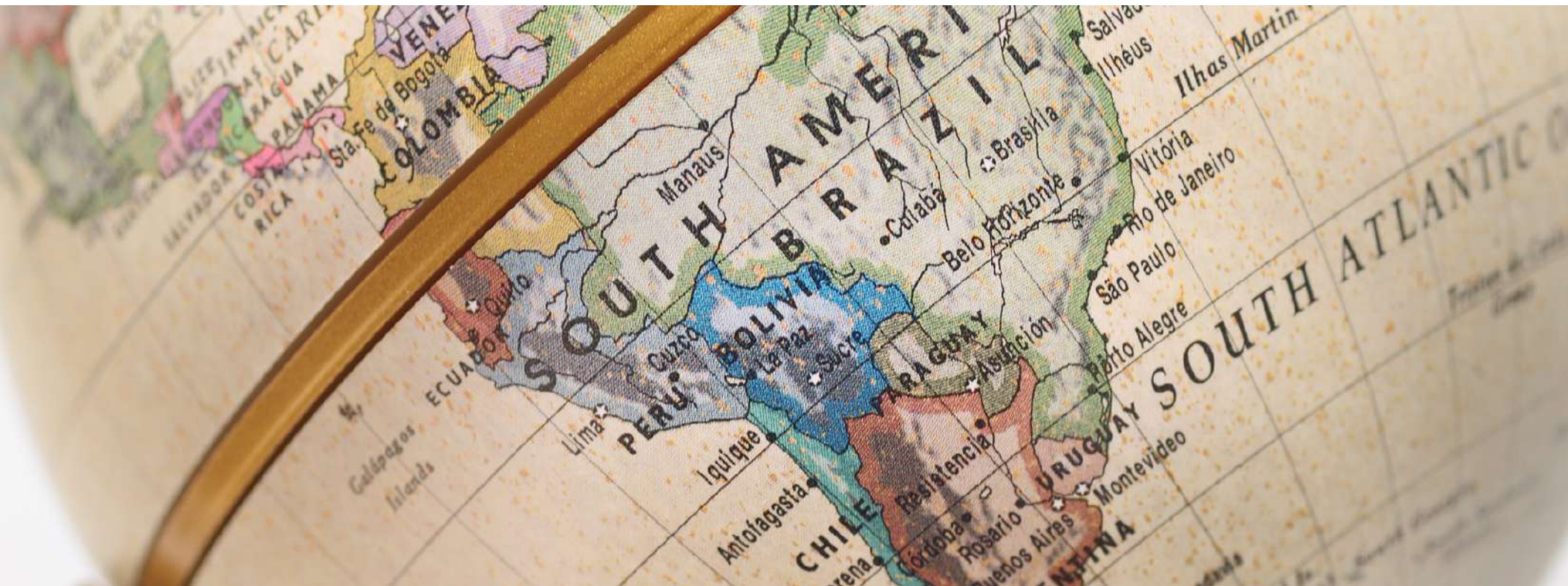

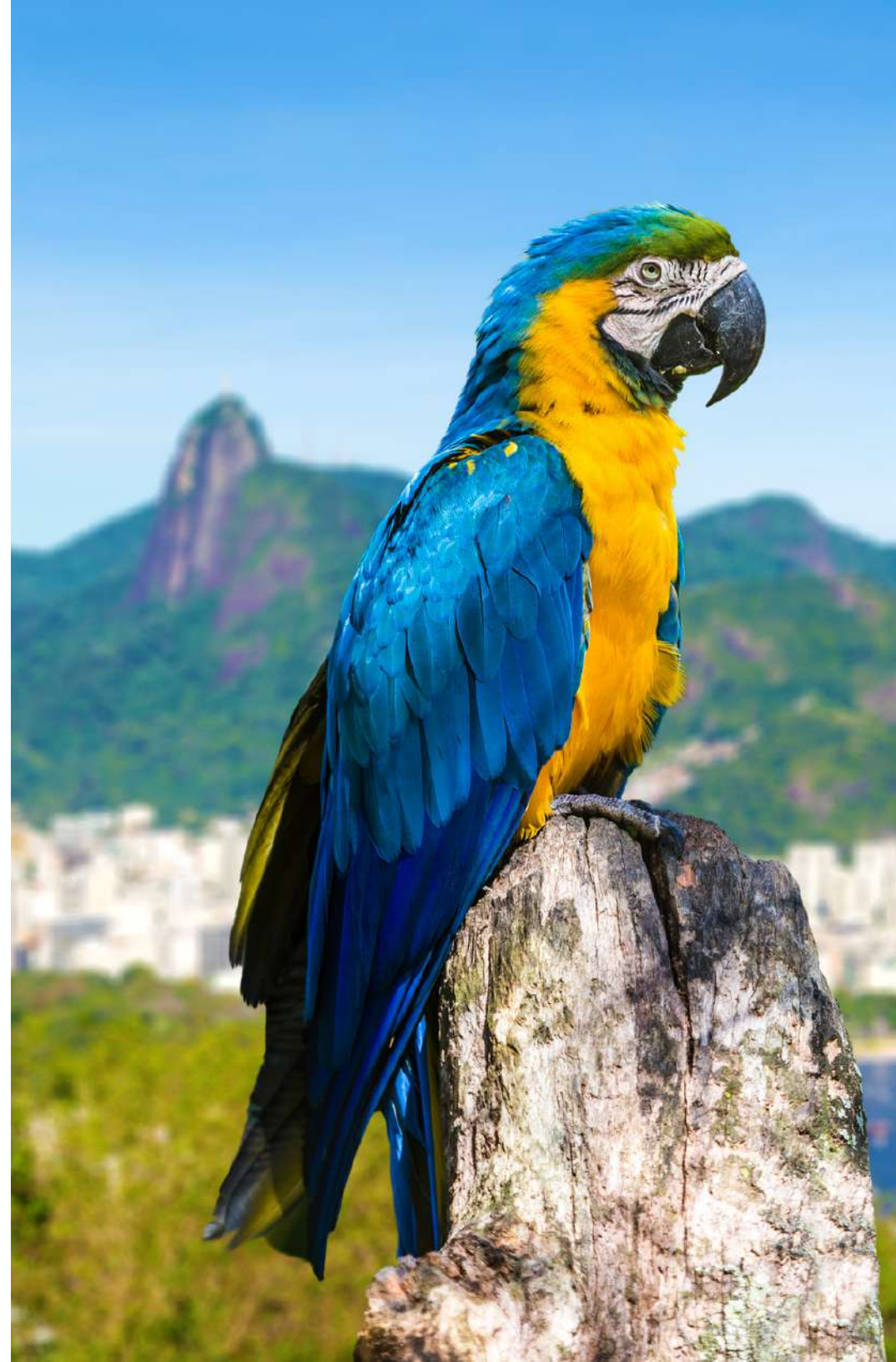
